You are the athletics director at a highly successful athletic department in a suburban high school. The realistic goal for your teams is to be in the mix for a sectional championship and more each year. Your community expects for teams to be at or near the top of the conference in most sports. This evaluation is for a baseball head coach. A summary of the season is listed below for your evaluation.

Season Accomplishments over the last four years:
